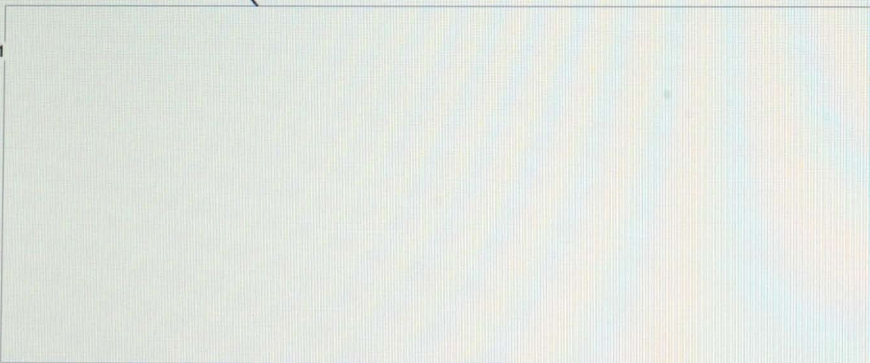

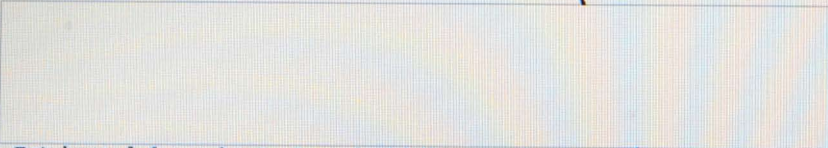

In London yesterday, Mrs. Thatcher presented to Parliament her Government's "approach" to Rhodesia. She said that the UK intends to sound out the Commonwealth countries at the Lusaka Conference next month and will formulate proposals to bring Rhodesia to independence with the "widest possible international acceptance". Significantly, she said that the proposals will be consonant with the independence procedures of other former colonies, a statement which allows for the UK requirement for constitutional changes while at the same time does not preclude some sort of minority protection. (Zambia's independence constitution included white protection arrangements.) The Prime Minister's statement followed the Foreign Office line closely.
