My dear Margaret,

As you will know, we have been looking into arrangements for the 1981 meeting in Australia of the Commonwealth Heads of Government.

In this connection our High Commission in London had been advised by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office of information from your office that the proposed dates of 21 - 28 October presented you with some difficulty. I understand also from the Commonwealth Secretary-General that you would find a time in the last week of September or the first week of October easier.

Because of the foregoing and also because of representations I have had from Mr Muldoon, we have reexamined most carefully the possibility of having the meeting in that earlier period.

We have established that it is not possible to run the meeting in the last week of September as residential accommodation in hotels will not be available.

However, by securing the cooperation of certain organisations which had made firm bookings of the Melbourne venue that we will be using for the meeting, it will now be possible to conduct the meeting from 30 September to 7 October 1981.

I am now writing to Mr Ramphal asking him to inform other Heads of Government that we plan that the meeting be held from 30 September to 7 October 1981.
