The Chancellor reported that the Secretary of State for Energy had been in touch with Sir Derek Ezra and had told him that the Government had no objection to the NCB providing a greater subsidy from within their existing cash limits. Department of Energy believed that the NCB had room for providing a further subsidy, and thus lowering the coking coal price. Chancellor suggested that it would be right to continue pressing Sir Derek on this point. The Prime Minister agreed. I am sending a copy of this letter to Bill Burroughs (Department of Energy).
