FCO: Lord Carrington and M. Jean Francois-Poncet. They met for an hour and a quarter and discussed Iran, Rhodesia and South Africa. There was no discussion of Europe.

D/Industry. Sir Keith Joseph and M. Andre Giraud. Met for about three-quarters of an hour and discussed the possibilities for collaboration in a number of fields including car production, television equipment, computers and textiles. Discussed Japanese import penetration of the European market and also the possibility of co-production of titanium (vital to aircraft manufacturers).

D/Energy. Mr David Howell and M. Giraud. Talks still continuing - said to be the usual "wide range of energy topics".

Treasury. Sir Geoffrey Howe and M. Rene Monory. Did not have separate talks. Merely travelled back together from Finance Ministers' meeting in Brussels.
