We feel it would be less unnerving for the two speakers if you could sit in the second row immediately behind them - are you content?

Gillian and Carl will speak for about three minutes each. Mr. Freud will then adjourn the meeting and lead you to the Members' tea room where 24 delegates to the Parliament will have assembled. You will then be free to mingle with and talk to the young people.

Press arrangements:

We expect a healthy turn-out: BBC radio and commercial radio will be recording your speech, as will ITN, BBC TV and Canadian Television. There will also be up to a dozen photographers and up to eight writing journalists. They will all work within the Council Chamber.

At the tea afterwards there will be only one photographer - working for the International Year of the Child.
