COMMENTS ON THE FALKLANDS BY GENERAL GALTIERI

1. WITH REFERENCE TO THE COPY OF THE NA'S MINUTE OF 23 MAY SENT IN LAST WEEKEND'S BAG, THE FOLLOWING IS THE RELEVANT PASSAGE FROM GALTIERI'S ARMY DAY SPEECH ON THE SAME DATE:-

QUOTE WE HAVE DEFENDED OUR COUNTRY'S IDENTITY FROM THE MARAUDERS, JUST AS WE SHALL DEFEND IT STRONGLY AGAINST ANY ATTEMPT TO UNDERMINE OUR TERRITORIAL SOVEREIGNTY. WE ARE NOT PREPARED TO SACRIFICE THE
