Dear Bishop Muzorewa

Thank you for your letter of 25 July, which I have received through Mr. Derek Day and which was awaiting me in London on my return from Lusaka. In the meantime, you will have received my message to you about the outcome of the Commonwealth Heads of Government meeting.

On the subject of Rhodesian representation in London, I quite understand that you wish people in the United Kingdom to be given a more accurate view of the changes that have taken place in Rhodesia. I fully support that objective and, as you know, the British Government are doing all they can to impress the facts of the situation on those who remain sceptical about the substantial progress that has already taken place. I am happy to say that we see no difficulty in your expanding the existing UANC office in London, so that its staff can undertake information activities of the kind you have in mind. I believe that this would be the best way of achieving your aims.
