Jear Ayous.

I wonder whether there is still time to insert into the document a paragraph identifying the need for a great improvement and expansion in vocational training - partly in school and partly day-release - to increase the skills, the self-respect and the earning power of a much larger proportion of our adolescents.

The draft touches on different aspects of this theme but nowhere draws it together. Our competitors are far ahead of us in this field and we would show ourselves aware by referring to it.
