Dear Prime Minister,

Since you were gracious enough to mention Bermuda's effort to raise money for the South Atlantic Fund during our meeting on the 8th of June, I am taking the liberty of forwarding with this letter a cheque for ±122,608.76 (BD\$215,497.16).

I am pleased to say that the largest amount, \$134,000, was contributed by individuals in Bermuda and is, I feel, very creditable for a population of some 53,000.

The ex-service associations - the Royal Navy, the Royal Air Force and Artillery raised \$30,000, while Government contributed \$50,000.

Our fervent hope is that there will not be a similar occurrence in the future but you can be assured that should such be the case Bermuda will be ready to assist in any way we can.
