PREPARATION OF THE EUROPEAN COUNCIL

1. AT COREPER LUNCH TODAY NOTERDAEME SAID THAT HE HAD BEEN ASKED BY MARTENS TO CONSULT HIS COLLEAGUES AND WORK OUT AN ORDER OF BUSINESS ACCEPTABLE TO ALL. AFTER DISCUSSION THE RESULT WAS AS FOLLOWS:

2. A. EEC/U.S. - POST VERSAILLES THERE WILL BE A VERY BRIEF COMMISSION PAPER DESCRIBING THE SUBJECTS NOW CAUSING DIFFICULTIES WITH THE U.S. HEADS OF GOVERNMENT MAY WISH TO COMMISSION DRAFTING

B. INVESTMENT THE PRESIDENCY PARTICULARLY WISH TO AVOID A LENGTHY DISCUSSION OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL SITUATION ALREADY COMPREHENSIVELY DISCUSSED IN MARCH AND AT VERSAILLES. WE WERE ASKED TO RECOMMEND AGAINST HEADS OF GOVERNMENT COMING WITH PREPARED SPEECHES. THE IDEA IS TO HAVE A RELATIVELY BRIEF DISCUSSION SO THAT ANY CONCLUSIONS DESIRED BY HEADS OF GOVERNMENT CAN THEN BE DRAFTED.

A. MIDDLE EAST/LEBANON; AND B. SOUTH ATLANTIC/LATIN AMERICA.

3. HEADS OF GOVERNMENT WILL DISCUSS "PERSPECTIVES FOR THE COMMUNITY". THIS WILL BE A FREE DISCUSSION FOR ANYONE WHO WANTS TO INTERVENE. IT WILL BE UNDERSTOOD THAT MITTERRAND WILL RAISE HIS POINT ABOUT ENLARGEMENT/CONSOLIDATION OF THE COMMUNITY AT THIS POINT. I SAID THAT THOUGH I HAD NO INSTRUCTIONS I THOUGHT IT POSSIBLE THAT THE PRIME MINISTER MIGHT HAVE SOME POINTS SHE WISHED TO MENTION.

4. FOREIGN MINISTERS WILL HAVE THEIR DISCUSSION OF POLITICAL COOPERATION SUBJECTS AND, IF NECESSARY, DEAL WITH THE NORTH/SOUTH ITEM.

TUESDAY MORNING

5. PAPANDEOU WILL MAKE HIS STATEMENT ON GREECE, AND OTHERS MAY WISH TO COMMENT. THE COUNCIL WILL THEN DISCUSS TEXTS BEGINNING WITH ECONOMIC, AND GOING ON TO POLITICAL.

6. NOTERDAEME SAID THAT MARTENS WOULD PROBABLY NOT WISH TO WRITE TO HEADS OF GOVERNMENT ON THIS OCCASION. WE COULD TAKE IT AS REASONABLY CERTAIN THAT THE COUNCIL WOULD PROCEED AS ABOVE UNLESS HEADS OF GOVERNMENT WOULD WISH TO CHANGE THE ORDER.
