GOVERNMENT PAPER ON WITHDRAWAL FROM THE EEC

There was a story circulating at the end of last week, which may have originated in Strasbourg, that the Government had drafted a paper on the consequences of our withdrawal from the EEC. The story went on that we were seriously considering this option.

- 2. If asked about this we can say that:
 - i The Prime Minister has repeatedly made it clear that this Government does not intend to withdraw from the Community.
 - ii We are not interested in studying an option ie withdrawal that does not exist in terms of Government policy.
 - iii Naturally we keep the costs and benefits of our membership of the EEC under continual review.
 - iv There is no Government paper recommending withdrawal.
