- 1. WHEN I CALLED ON DR BRZEZINSKI THIS MORNING, HE TOLD ME THAT
 THE WHITE HOUSE WERE GRAPPLING WITH A TRICKY PROTOCOL PROBLEM OVER
 MRS THATCHER'S REQUEST TO SEE THE PRESIDENT DURING HER VISIT IN
 SEPTEMBER. MR MITTERAND WAS ALSO DUE IN WASHINGTON AND IT WAS CLEAR
 THAT IT WOULD NOT BE EASILY UNDERSTOOD BY PRESIDENT GISCARD IF THE
 PRESIDENT RECEIVED MR MITTERAND. BUT HOW WOULD THE WHITE HOUSE
 JUSTIFY THE PRESIDENT RECEIVING MRS THATCHER AND NOT MR MITTERAND?
- 2. DR BRZEZINSKI TOLD ME THAT THE WHITE HOUSE WAS PLAYING WITH THREE POSSIBLE FORMULAE:-
- (A) A BLANKET RULE THAT OPPOSITION LEADERS WERE ALWAYS SEEN BY THE VICE PRESIDENT:
- (B) A RULE BASED ON A DISTINCTION BETWEEN LEADERS OF GENUINELY DEMOCRATIC PARTIES IN OPPOSITION, WHO COULD BE SEEN BY THE PRESIDENT, AND LEADERS OF COALITONS INVOLVING NON-DEMOCRATIC ELEMENTS, WHO WOULD NOT BE SEEN BY THE PRESIDENT: AND

 (C) THE BLANKET RULE AT (A) ABOVE: MODIFIED IN MRS THATCHER'S CASE BY RECOGNITION THAT A PERSONAL PROMISE HAD ALREADY BEEN GIVEN TO MRS THATCHER AND THAT THE WHITE HOUSE DID NOT BELIEVE IN RETROACTIVE LEGISLATION.
- 3. I MADE IT CLEAR THAT MRS THATHER WOULD BE VERY DISAPPOINTED

 /F THE MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT WHICH SHE EXPECTED WAS NOT HELD.

 I MENTIONED HER FORMAL STATUS AS LEADER OF HER MAJESTY'S LOYAL

 OPPOSITION. I SAID THAT, WHILE I OF COURSE UNDERSTOOD THE

 DIFFICULTIES, WE NATURALLY HOPED THAT THE WHITE HOUSE WOULD FIND

 A WAY OF ARRANGING IT.
