I. The remit of the Policy Groups will generally be

"To identify tasks for Conservative administration during the rest of this decade. To make proposals for action where possible. Where this is not possible, to identify subjects for further study".

II Subjects for Policy Groups

- 1. Unemployment
- 2. Promotion of Enterprise
- 3. The family, and women's affairs
- 4. Constitutional matters
- 5. Extension of choice (vouchers, BUPA, private pension provision etc)
- 6. Education for life and work
- 7. The future of cities; law and order, etc
- 8. Poverty trap, Why Work? Tax and social security
- 9. The membership of the EEC, and problems arising
- 10. Nationalised industries and privatisation
- 11. Problems of urban transport

III Timing

- (b) Groups to discuss framework and programme of work with convening minister in September.
- (c) Reports expected before end March 1983.
