Forecasts based on the latest national and regional opinion polls are attached. They are calculated from the new boundaries as well as the old, so that the beneficial effects of the new boundaries can be seen.

A summary of the overall majorities yielded by the forecasts is as follows:

The only result which is substantially out of line is the forecast based on the outcome of the Darlington bye-election. Although the swing in that bye-election was only 1.3% from Tories to Labour, the substantial swings from the Tories to the Alliance would strongly benefit Labour.

ANALYSIS OF THE FORECASTS

It is at once evident that the old boundaries, which were unfair to the Conservatives, yield poorer overall results for them than the new. My estimates of how the nation would have voted at the last General Election on the new boundaries (attached) show that the Tory majority would have been 26 seats greater in 1979. The mainframe computer used by the television companies estimates that the overall Tory advantage would have been 27 seats.

However, the forecasts show that, with the substantial Tory lead given by all the opinion polls, the Tory advantage from the new boundaries would be greater now than it would have been on the basis of the 1979 general election result.

The Darlington bye-election result is less untypical of the probable national picture than Bermondsey was, but it underestimates national support for the Conservatives. It is likely that the correct figures lie somewhere well above those suggested by Darlington and rather below those suggested by the opinion polls.

All the polls show that Labour, rather than the SDP, is the real threat. Labour has a solidly loyal core of voters who will vote for it come what

may. The main thrust of our election campaign should therefore be directed against Labour.

The SDP would gain an at first sight surprisingly small number of seats. Even with the national vote of 29% forecast by the Gallup poll in yesterday's Daily Telegraph, they would have only 30 seats. The reason is that the country is strongly polarised between constituencies which with large Conservative majorities and constituencies with large Labour ones. On present figures the SDP would do well only in those seats where the Liberals are strong and, to a lesser extent, in those seats which are marginal between the Conservatives and Labour.

The computer program, however, is likely to underestimate the effect of a substantial SDP vote in marginals where the Liberals were not previously strong, and it ignores all bye-elections, including those in seats won by the Alliance. It may therefore be prudent to adjust the SDP figures up by 10 to 20 seats, of which half would come from each of the other two major parties.

#### IMPLICATIONS OF THE FORECASTS

1. Go for June. Assuming that the Darlington result works beneficially by reminding Tory voters (and Tory back-benchers) not to be complacent, and assuming that the economic situation does not measurably deteriorate in the short term, serious consideration should be given to a general election at the end of June.

2. Go for Labour. They are the greater threat. Their proposed policies have received very little attention from Ministers and we must be ready with serious arguments against what they are advocating when the campaign comes. An interesting feature of the Bermondsey and Darlington campaigns was the rejection of Leftism by the voters. We must take advantage by pointing out how extreme Labour's policies are, however non-extreme the party's leaders may make themselves out to be. Since Labour has no credible leader at present, the campaign cannot be based solely or primarily on personalities. This time it is the policies we must expose and attack, rather than the front-men.

3. Prepare policies for a big overall majority. Although the campaign, which tends to favour the non-governing parties by giving them equal attention, which they do not normally get and seldom if ever deserve, it is possible that the Conservatives will have an overall majority of more than 100 seats in the next Parliament. Therefore a programme of unpopular but necessary legislation should be at once prepared, so that we do not waste the one-year electoral honeymoon we wasted in 1979. Chancellor Kohl has shown the way in West Germany by introducing immediate reductions in benefits. We must be equally decisive and equally quick - and that means preparation.

4. Resist pressure from the civil service and from interest-groups for filling the legislative timetable with trivia. The first year of the next Parliament must be kept clear for those major policy initiatives which the Cabinet may wish to take: eg trade union reform, an increased pace of privatisation, abolition of dispensable Departments, abolition of metropolitan counties, reform of the rates (perhaps by a sales tax), major reductions in public spending, etc.

5. Resist complacency on the Tory back-benches and among party workers. We must not assume that this election is going to be an easy ride, whatever the opinion polls may show. Only one or two percentage points off the Tory national vote and on to the Labour one could halve the overall majority we hope to get. And we should use the argument that a really convincing win might finish Labour and the Alliance off for good and all and lead to the emergence of an altogether more moderate Opposition, giving us the possibility of winning not only the forthcoming General Election but the one after that as well.
