THE BACKCLOTH REMAINS - AS ALWAYS -

- THE EXPANSIONIST POLICIES OF SOVIET UNION
- THEIR MASSIVE MILITARY BUILD-UP
- THE NATURE OF THE SOVIET REGIME AS TYPIFIED BY THE BRUTAL SHOOTING DOWN OF THE KAL AIRLINER
- THE SOVIET PROPAGANDA CAMPAIGN DIRECTED OVER THE HEADS OF GOVERNMENT TO THE PEOPLES OF EUROPE

THE SOVIET LEADERS MUST BE BEGINNING TO REALISE THAT THEIR PROPAGANDA HAS FAILED. I AND CHANCELLOR KOHL FOUGHT OUR ELECTIONS ON THE CLEAR AND UNEQUIVOCAL POLICY OF THE NATO DOUBLE DECISION - AND WON WITH INCREASED MAJORITIES. EUROPE WILL STAND FIRM. NATO under the Leadership of the United States is doing both - the process of consultation has been good.

In answer to the Soviet propaganda initiatives which evaporate when tested at the negotiating table, President Reagan on Behalf of the Alliance has put forward two major proposals in the INF negotiations.

- THE ZERO OPTION
- THE INTERIM REDUCTIONS IF ZERO CANOT BE ACHIEVED

And on Monday, again after full consultation, he put forward three further proposals which show the sincerity and flexibility of our approach. That is the right course to take. The relationship with the Soviet Union is the major issue facing the NATO Alliance today. Let us keep our priorities fixed on that.

As in any alliance of individual and democratic countries we have our differences and our national interests. In that too lies our strength. But we must ensure that the differences between us are kept in proportion and do not escalate to damage our wider unity of purpose. You know that we in Britain - and other countries too - have serious workies about your Export Administration Act

- YOUR UNITARY TAXATION
- Other protectionist measures (though none of us are wholly blameless in that field )

BUT LET US FORESEE THE PROBLEMES AND EXAMINE THEM TOGETHER, WITH THE AIM OF EASING THEM - AND NOT WITH THE AIM OF ONE OR OTHER SIDE WINNING ITS POINT OF VIEW. AND LET US KEEP OUR EYES FIXED ON THE MAIN THREAT TO OUR SECURITY AND WAY OF LIFE - AND ON THE NEED TO REMAIN STRONG AND UNITED.
