THANK YOU FOR ARRANGING FOR MR DORR TO GIVE ME THE EXCELLENT NEWS OF MR DON TIDEY'S RESCUE BY YOUR SECURITY FORCES. I AM VERY GLAD THAT THE PERSISTENCE, ENERGY AND DEDICATION SHOWN BY THE GARDA AND THE IRISH ARMY DURING THE SEARCH FOR MR TIDEY HAVE BEEN REWARDED. I UNDERSTAND THAT GREAT GALLANTRY WAS DISPLAYED BY THOSE WHO RELEASED MR TIDEY. OFFER MY CONGRATULATIONS TO ALL CONCERNED. AT THE SAME TIME I AM DEEPLY SADDENED TO HEAR THAT TWO MEMBERS OF THE IRISH SECURITY FORCES HAVE BEEN KILLED AND OTHERS INJURED IN THE COURSE OF THE OPERATION. I SHOULD LIKE TO CONVEY MY DEEPEST SYMPATHY THROUGH YOU TO THE FAMILIES AND COLLEAGUES OF THOSE KILLED. I SEND TO THE INJURED MY BEST WISHES FOR THEIR EARLY RECOVERY. ENDS.
