Thank you for your moving letter of 8 December.

The brutal murder of Edgar Graham was a terrible tragedy and I have of course written to his parents.

Since that outrage, we have had the further appalling event in London on Saturday 17 December.

The Government is of course looking afresh at the whole problem of terrorism. Our will to defeat it is unqualified. I shall bear in mind everything you say. We must make sure that anything we do is properly designed to deal with this evil scourge.
