A. The Price Code

The following points were agreed:

(1) Food prices were politically more important than other prices. The possibility of abolishing overall price control while introducing a code of practice, voluntarily agreed with the food manufacturers, should be exemined.

(2) It was important for the party to be ready to make a public statement on the Consultative Document on the Price Code.

B. ir. Ridley's paper on Reviving the Private Sector

 Mr. Ridley's paper (RG/10/76/23) was discussed. It was agreed that it could form the basis of a document to be presented to the Industry conference in early July, but the drafting presentation would need to be very different.

 Faragraphs 5, and 6, of the paper were correct, but their majivis should not, perhaps, be used in public. The potential for growth in national income perhaps were a long period arising from restriction profits and vages ignored in order to stress the eventual increase in gross removeration.

3. Paragraphs 10.(a), (b) and (c) were correct. 10.(d) was vary important, but caution should be exercised over the point made in it about use of the banking system. The recommendation in 10.(f) was difficult to implement; this highlighted the need to develop our policies for the labour market.

C. The next meeting

The next meeting of the Group would be at 10.00 a.m. on Thursday, 17th June. A number of basic institutional questions would be discussed.
