1. Please seek an early personal interview to deliver following message to President Shagari:
"Dear Mr President
I was most grateful to receive your reply to my appeal for support over the falkland Islands issue. It is good, in times like these, to be able to count one's friends. At this moment, we still cannot see how things will go: but you may. rest assured that we shall continue to do our utmost to arrive at a negotiated solution consistent with our principles and in particular the wishes of the islanders themselves, the very point which Nigeria's statement on the Falkland Islands issue so correctly stresses.
"I should not like you to think that we are aware only of our own problems. We are extremely conscious of the difficulties which the weaknesses in oil prices has caused Nigeria.

Indeed, we too have suffered a loss of Government revenue as a result of the weakening of world demand for oil. The British Government has absolutely no interest in de-stabilisation of the oil market. As you correctly stated in your historic statement on the special joint session of the Nigerian National Assembly on 19 April, 'the nations of the world, big or small, rich or poor, are all mutually interdependent and our interests are complementary'. We have noted with interest the economic programme which you announced on that occasion and I send you my very best wishes for its success.
