- WE DERIEFED JEREMY THORPE AND THE TWO JOURNALISTS WHO HAD WED MRS GANDHI. THE JOURNALISTS SEEM TO HAVE BEEN USING MRS MATCHER'S VISIT AS AN EXCUSE FOR GETTING INTO INDIA, AND WERE CENTRATING ON INDIAN POINTS. MR THORPE'S DISCUSSION RANGED MORE WIDELY. MRS GANDHI DID QUESTION HIM CLOSELY ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NATIONAL FRONT BUT SHOWED NO PARTICULAR CONCERN FOR THE LOT OF INDIANS RESIDENT IN THE UK.
- 3. MRS THATCHER'S MEETING WITH CHAVAN TOUCHED ON THE FOLLOWING ...
- (A) RELAXATION OF RESTRICTIONS ON FOREIGN CORRESPONDENTS. AS
 ALREADY REPORTED, MRS GANDHI'S PRIVATE SECRETARY IS BELIEVED TO HAVE
 ATTRIBUTED THIS RELAXATION TO THE EMBARRASSMENT THAT WOULD
 BE CAUSED IF THE BAN WERE MAINTAINED DURING MRS THATCHER'S VISIT.
- (P) NON ALIGNED CONFERENCE. CHAVAN EMPHASISED ECONOMIC PROBLEMS
 AND THE IMPORTANCE OF COOPERATION BETWEEN THE DEVELOPED AND UNDER
 DEVELOPED COUNTRIES.
- (5) THE SUBCONTINENT PAKISTAN, BANGLADESH AND SOUTH EAST ASIA.
- 4. MRS THATCHER VISITED THE IMMIGRATION SECTION, AND SAT, IN UPON PART OF ONE INTERVIEW. SHE THEN MET ALL AVAILABLE ECOS, PLUS SUPERVISING STAFF, AND ASKED THE DAILY RUN OF BUSINESS. SHE WAS MORE CONCERNED ABOUT MUTS AND BOLTS THAN WITH STATISTICS. TRENDS, ETC, AND DID NOT EXPRESS ANY VIEWS ON THE MALE FLANCE PROBLEM. AND MRS THATCHER. MRS GANDHI HAD APPARENTLY REMARKED TO HER STAFF

THAT THOUGH THERE WERE QUITE A NUMBER OF SUBJECTS ON WHICH

SHE AND MRS THATCHER DISAGREED, SHE HAD BEEN AGREEABLY

SURPRISED BY THE POSITIVE AND BUSINESS-LIKE NATURE OF MRS

THATCHER'S APPROACH AND THE DIRECT AND NO-NONSENSE WAY IN

MAICH SHE PUT ACROSS HER OWN VIEWS SO THAT THEY COULD BE

PEADILY UNDERSTOOD.
