1. Themes: Questions

The meeting concentrated on further refinement of Themes into Questions, particularily bearing in mind that KJ's remit referred to international comparisons.

(a) Distribution of Wealth and Income.

Questions to be answered included:-

"Is there greater or less (i) inequality (ii) poverty internationally than in the UK?"

KJ would arrange for Norman Lamont MP to contact SW for involvment in this subject.

(b) Profits etc. (The 'Sextet').

SW should contact the Finance Directors of ICI and Unilever; KJ would arrange an introduction to BAT and also handed SW a draft reply to Reckitta & Colman for comment.

SW would ascertain Brian Griffith's capacity to contribute on the question of Protection of Savings.

KJ would arrange a dinner in July to explore which Sextet questions were most relevant. An example might be:"What is the overall relationship of profits to GNP, taxation and growth?"

(c) Money Supply: Unemployment: Bankruptcies.

SW would talk to Alan Walters to assess how he could best contribute to:-

"What correlation is there between Money Supply: Unemployment: Bank-ruptcies?"

KJ would arrange for Nick Edwards MP and Bill Shelton MP to contact SW for involvement in this subject.

(d) Socialist Market Economics.

It was agreed that, rather than concentrate on defing specific questions, this would be a fruitful area for provision of anecdotal material as soon as possible. Examples could be under the general heading:
"Lack of consumer satisfaction"

AS and SW would liase to find an appropriate journalist to investigate this.

3. KJ's Speeches.

KJ would make his first speech on Saturday 22 June. He would delay circulation of fund-raising letters until after then.

KJ asked for ideas on the precise definition of productivity and its role.
