Election of the Leader

I have received a valid nomination in your name. I have confirmed this to the retiring Executive.

Elections for the Officers and Executive of the 1922 Committee will take place on Thursday 10 November.

Rule 2 of the Procedure provides that there shall be election for the Leader of the Conservative Party within 28 days of the opening of each new session of Parliament, i.e. before 30 November; the actual date to be determined by the Leader of the Party in consultation with the Chairman of the 1922 Committee.
