I thought you might like to know of the main points that Michael Foot made at the Guinea Club Lunch yesterday.

1. He expressed concern that Bill Rodgers did not accept a post.

2. He was confident that Healey and Shore will cobble together a policy to take us out of the EEC.

3. He restated his views in favour of unilateral disarmament.

4. He said he would send back Cruise Missiles.

5. The Labour Party will have devolution proposals in its next manifesto.
